There is no cost to the competitors. All ladies will use the same provided cart. Please wear closed toe shoes. Please bring a helmet with you, or one will be provided. All competitors will sign a liability waiver before competing in the competition. Participants must be a minimum of 18 years old with a valid driver's license. Each participant will get to ride the course twice. The best time will be entered.

When: Thursday September 4, 2025, 9a.m.-12p.m. & Friday, September 5, 2025, 8a.m.-11a.m.

Where: The parking lots of the Mid Atlantic Association of Shriners Motor Corps Competition area at the Virginia Beach Sports Center, 1045 19th St. Look for the large pink flag or ask any Mid Atlantic Association of Shriners Motor Corps Officer to point you in the right direction.

Results: All competitors of the Hell on Wheels Competition are invited to the Mid Atlantic Association of Shriners Motor Corps Awards Lunch. The top 2 drivers in the competition will be awarded and recognized. The lunch will begin at 1:30p.m., Friday September 6th, at the Family Fun Experience, at 206 16th St, Virginia Beach, VA 23451. The lunch is free of charge.
